DausHaus Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy describes the privacy practices for DausHaus's websites located at www.DausHaus.com, www.FunCarArt.com, www.WindowDecorate.com, and www.RoundHealth.com. The term "DausHaus" or "us" or "we" or "our" refers to DausHaus, the owner of the DausHaus family of websites. The term "you" refers to the user or viewer of our website. Please read this Privacy Policy carefully to understand how your personal information will be treated while you use our website and any of the services we offer. By using our website you consent to our collection and use of your personal information as described in this Privacy Policy. We may change or modify this Privacy Policy from time to time, and will post any such changes on our website.

It is your responsibility to regularly review this Privacy Policy.

This Privacy Policy is incorporated into and is subject to the DausHaus Terms of Use. If you do not agree to the terms of this privacy policy or the DausHaus terms and conditions of use, do not provide DausHaus with any information and do not use the DausHaus website or services.

Information Collection and Use. DausHaus is the sole owner of all personal and contact information collected about you on this website.

Registration and Collection of Information. In order to use certain services available on the DausHaus site, a user must complete the registration form. During registration, users are required to give their contact information (such as name and email address). This information is used to contact the users about the products and services for which they have expressed interest. When you order any product or service for which we charge a fee, we need to know your name, email address, mailing address, credit card number, and expiration date. This allows us to process and fulfill your order and to notify you of your order status. In addition, we may collect such information when you register with our website and in connection with your transactions with us and some of our business partners. Our servers may automatically receive and record information about you on our server logs.

Cookies. A cookie is a piece of data stored on the user's hard drive containing information about the user. Usage of a cookie is in no way linked to any personally identifiable information while on our site. Once the user closes his or her browser, the cookie terminates. If a user rejects a cookie, he or she may still visit our site. The only drawback to this is that the user will be limited in some areas of the site or have to log in his or her password multiple times. Cookies can also enable us to track and target the interests of our users to enhance their experience on our site. Some of our business affiliates, such as advertisers, may use cookies on our site, but we have no access to or control over those cookies. We may let our advertisers set and access their cookies on your computer. Our advertisers do not have access to our cookies.

Log Files. We may use IP addresses to analyze trends, administer our site, track users' movements, and gather broad demographic information for aggregate use. IP addresses are not linked to personally identifiable information.

Surveys and Contests. From time-to-time our site may request information from users via surveys or contests. Participation in these surveys or contests is completely voluntary and the user therefore has a choice whether or not to disclose this information. Information requested may include contact information (such as name and shipping address) and demographic information (such as zip code, age level).

Use of Information. We do not share your personally identifiable information with outside parties. We may share aggregated demographic information with our business affiliates and advertisers. We may use cookies to assist in keeping track of your preferences and user settings, estimate and report our total number of users and usage traffic, and help us improve the content and services provided in connection with our website and services. We may use your IP address to diagnose and prevent or resolve technology problems, estimate the number of users from certain geographic areas or monitor and prevent abuse of the Service. We may enter into an arrangement with a third party to provide specific services or products. When the user signs up for these services or products, we will share the names or other contact information that is necessary for that third party to provide the services or products. Those third parties are not allowed to use personally identifiable information for any purpose other than providing those services or products.

Security Measures and Limits on Our Abilities. We make efforts to ensure data security on our systems to protect against unauthorized access to or unauthorized alteration, disclosure or destruction of data. However, no data transmissions

over the Internet can be guaranteed to be secure. As a result, we cannot ensure or warrant the security of any information you transmit to us and you do so at your own risk.

Collecting Personal Information from the Site. You may not collect, use or store any personal information about other users on the site for any purpose whatsoever unless the user invites you to do so. In all circumstances, you may not use robots, scripts or other automated procedures to collect any information, including user contact information, from our site.

Government Relations and Lawsuits. In some cases, disclosure of information about you, including your personal information, may be required by law or the government, and in such cases, DausHaus will disclose such information as is necessary to comply. DausHaus may also unilaterally turnover information about you to the government if it believes such disclosure to be appropriate, in which case you authorize it to do so.

Transfer of Business. If we sell our business or all or part of the website and/or services, personally identifiable information you have shared with us may be one of the business assets that will be transferred. The transferred personally identifiable information will remain subject to the promises made in this privacy policy or subsequent policies to which you have consented.

Minors. If you are under the age of 13, you are not permitted to use any products or services on our site.
